Remember the **PASS** word (Pull - Aim - Squeeze - Sweep)

↓ Break seal and test extinguisher	↓ Ensure you have a means of escape	↓ To operate extinguisher and discharge the agent	↓ Completely extinguish the fire

The lion is now worn out, and still hungry!


